Tournament Information

- 75% rule for playing time.

- 6. Kicks from the penalty mark




Sportsmanship

 - You do not have to allow the other team to score, just pull in your team
 - No shutout points
- Shake hands with the other team after game
- Coaches sign the game cards & match reports

- Jersey tucked in
- Black shorts
- Black socks with three white stripes pulled up
- Proper AYSO badge
- Black shoes
- Other jersey colors OK (officials must match)





Referee Information

- Ensure You Report to Check-In Prior to Start of Games
- Roll call players from Roster during player inspection
- Noise-makers, air horns, etc. Law 5



- Youth Referees
 - Zero tolerance for harassment
 - Must have an authoritatively capable adult at game

- Start Games on Time. Sunset on Saturday is at 5:52 PM.
- No waiting for teams, forfeit if they are late (forfeits must be verified with T. D.)
- Finish the game on time.
- Time Change is Saturday Night.
- Sunset on Sunday is at 4:51 PM.



- Regular rules on player equipment
- Eye glasses and knee <u>braces</u> are OK
- Splints/Casts are an absolute NO NO
- Cold weather, check the rules, jersey must be showing
- No guest players



- Fun, Fair, Safe
- Avoid trifling stoppages
- What you don't call you encourage
- Referee has the whistle, don't argue
- No coaching from the spectators
- Area staff will not overrule the referee
- Alabama Code Section 13A-11-144
 - Harassment of a sports official is a Class B misdemeanor



- Coach Sendoff Minus 3 Points
- Player Sendoff Minus 2 Point
- Player Caution No Points
- Sendoff's carry over to the State Tournament




Self assign most games using Sportacus
